Property:

The Community of Capodarco Linguaglossa was founded in Linguaglossa in 1986 by Concettina Pafumi and Giuseppe Cannavò. Building works of the Campus started in 2002 and ended in 2008 and they were funded by Lions International. The Community works with disabled people with the proposal of an interpersonal relation model, where solutions are based on needs. It promotes the creation, promotion and enhancement of solidarity networks. Today, the Campus is a reality which works in a difficult context, where young people with special needs are educated and integrated, though a fight against discrimination.

Accessibility:

Accessible rooms: 8 rooms wide enough for wheelchairs (even the bathroom); furniture is arranged to enable the free movement in the room. Bathrooms have an easily accessible alarm. Showers have grab bars and no gaps; a movable chair is available.

Entrance: there are 2 steps

Reception: there are firm stand supports.

Common areas: there are no obstacles; there are no smooth and slippery floors, disconnected floors or protruding plates, nor fitted carpeting, high carpets and doormats.

Lift: one well-lighted lift with no gaps at the arrival, equipped with buttons in relief and Braille.

Parking: 10 parking spaces for disabled people, 5 m away from the main entrance. It is an outdoor parking with a valet service. Floor is made of asphalt, gravel and stone plates.

Restaurant: high tables suitable to wheelchairs. There are also 4 tables with 4 legs.

Special menus: menus for people with celiac disorder, diabetes, high-blood pressure and lactose intolerance.

Allergies: Polyester hypoallergenic linens and duvets, pillows and mattresses made of synthetic material. Wool blankets are used.

Other: the property offers a support service and a campus with a rehabilitation and social tourism service.
